IT IS ADJUDGED that:

- 1. The Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of the parties of this cause.
- There are no genuine issues of material fact; therefore, Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment of Foreclosure is GRANTED.

- 6. Plaintiff shall advance all subsequent costs of this action and shall be reimbursed for them by the Clerk if Plaintiff is not the purchaser of the property for sale, provided, however, that the purchaser of the property for sale shall be responsible for documentary stamps payable on the certificate of title. If Plaintiff is the purchaser, the Clerk shall credit Plaintiff's bid with the total sum with interest and costs accruing subsequent to this judgment, or such part of it, as is necessary to pay the bid in full.
- 7. On filing the Certificate of Title, the Clerk shall distribute the proceeds of the sale, so far as they are sufficient, by paying: first, all of the Plaintiff's costs; second, documentary stamps affixed to the Certificate; third, Plaintiff's attorneys' fees; fourth, the total sum due to the Plaintiff, less the items paid, plus interest at the rate prescribed in Paragraph 3 from this date to the date of the sale; and by

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retaining any remaining amount pending the further order of this Court. If proceeds are to be distributed to Plaintiff or Plaintiff's Counsel, the Clerk is authorized to issue a single check made payable to counsel for Plaintiff.

- 8. On filing of the Certificate of Sale, Defendant(s) and all persons claiming under or against Defendant(s) since the filing of the Notice of Lis Pendens shall be foreclosed of all estate or claim in the property, except as to claims or rights under Chapter 718 or Chapter 720, Florida Statutes, if any. Upon the filing of the Certificate of Title, the person named on the Certificate of Title shall be let into possession of the property. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the rights of any condominium or homeowners' association to collect unpaid assessments from any subsequent title holder, including the first mortgage holder, shall be preserved and shall be governed as provided in Section 718.116 and 720.3085, Florida Statutes, subject to limitations as set-forth in *Coral Lakes Community Association, Inc. v. Busey Bank, N.A.*, 30 So. 3d 579 (Fla. 2d DCA 2010).
- 9. The court finds, based upon the affidavits/testimony presented and upon inquiry of counsel for the Plaintiff, that 7.80 hours were reasonably expended by Plaintiff's counsel and that an hourly rate of \$250.00 is appropriate. Plaintiff's counsel represents that the attorneys' fees awarded does not exceed its contract fee with the Plaintiff. The court finds that there is/are no reduction or enhancement factors for consideration by the court pursuant to *Florida Patients Compensation Fund v. Rowe*, 472 So. 2D 1145 (Fla. 1985).

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- 10. The Court retains jurisdiction of this action to enter further orders that are proper, including, without limitation, writs of possession, deficiency judgments, reforeclosure or a supplemental complaint to add an omitted party post-judgment.
- 11. The Final Judgment is an *in rem* judgment against the Defendant(s): **THOMAS**

B. FINNEY, and there are no in personam damages or costs against said

Defendant(s). A deficiency judgment may be sought against only those defendants

who executed or assumed the Note, who were personally served in this action, and

whose debts have not been discharged in bankruptcy.
